This Agreement entered into this the 13th day of March 1880 between James M. Corbitt, Merchant and doing business at Baykins Depot Virginia of one part and Hardy, Artis of the other part. Witness etc. That whereas the said Hardy, Artis is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain during the year 1880, advances in supplies from the said James M. Corbitt, to the amount of five hundred dollars, beyond which limit amount he shall not go, and the said James M. Corbitt having agreed on his part to furnish said amount of advances. Now the said Hardy, Artis on his part in consideration of the above premises does hereby grant a Lien upon to the said James M. Corbitt on the crops which may be made during the year 1880, upon the lands in cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended. This Lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved
