

Elias Vial
declines to
O.M. W.M. Beaton

This Agreement entered into this 21st day of February 1859 between Wm. M. Beaton, Walter Boone and S. L. Beaton Merchants and partners trading under the firm name of W. M. Beaton & Co. of one part and Elias Vial of the other part Witnesseth: That whereas the said Elias Vial is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain during the year 1859 advances in supplies from the said W. M. Beaton & Co. to the amount of Four Hundred Dollars which limit the said Elias Vial shall not go, and the said W. M. Beaton & Co. having agreed on their part to furnish the said advances, now the said Elias Vial on his part in consideration of the above premises, does hereby grant a Lien to the said Wm. M. Beaton & Co. on all the crops which may be made during the year 1859 upon the lands in cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended. This Lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1853 entitled "An Act to secure Advances for Agricultural Purposes" Witness the following Signatures
