

Said Joshua B. Powell upon all crops that may be made on the Lands cultivated by the said William Stith during the year 1880. The said William Stith farther agrees to deliver to the said Joshua B. Powell all cotton and other produce made on said lands during the year 1880 to satisfy the amt. as aforesaid, and after all claims held by the said Joshua B. Powell is settled, balance of said proceeds is to be paid over to the said William Stith or his assigns. The said Joshua B. Powell also agrees to furnish the said William Stith with sufficient team and tools to carry on said farming operations, the said William Stith in consideration farther agrees that said Lands shall be tilled in good order, if not, the said Joshua B. Powell is to hire sufficient Labor to carry on said farming operations, and charge expenses of said Labor to the said William Stith and deduct the expenses of said Labor from the said William Stith's proceeds at the fall 1880, as aforesaid.

This Lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, Approved April 2nd: 1876 entitled "An act to secure advances for Agricultural Purposes."

Powell of one part and Warley Moody of the other part both parties of the State of Virginia and County of Southampton Witnesseth: that whereas the said Warley Moody is about to engage in the cultivation of the Lands owned by Joshua B. Powell, and is desirous to obtain during the year 1880. Advances in supplies from the said Joshua B. Powell to the amount of one hundred Dollars, beyond which limit the said Warley Moody shall not go, and the said Joshua B. Powell
