with the said Wm. M. Beaton that there is no encumbrance
on the said mules, that I have a good right to sell the same,
and will warrant and defend the title thereto to the said
Wm. M. Beaton his heirs &c against the lawful claims of
any or all persons whomsoever. Witness my hand and seal
this 10th day of March 1850.

along the Mumf's line to a corner, thence in a southerly
direction along a line of chopped trees to the public
path, thence along said path in a Northwest direction
to a branch, thence along a line of chopped trees to the
