Neugram and Rosa A. his wife in consideration of the sum of Seventy Dollars the receipt of which Wm: Neugram is hereby acknowledged, doth sell, grant, and convey unto Wm: E. Leigh all their title and interest in a certain parcel of land, bounded as follows, by a line commencing at in the Branch in front of the City Place, at a corner of W. E. Leigh's line; thence down said Branch thirty three poles, thence northward along a line of chopped trees to J. E. P. Turner's line, thence Eastward along said line to Wm: E. Leigh's line, thence Southward along said line to the place of beginning, containing Thirty acres to be the same more or less. Given under our hands and seals the day and year above written.
