

This Deed made this 18th day of February in the year 1880 between A. M. Drinn of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and K. A. Griffin trustee of said County and State of the second part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said party of the first part doth grant, bargain, sell and convey and by these presents hath granted & bargained, sold and conveyed unto the said party of the second part all of that certain Stock of Goods contained in the Grocery and Liquor Stores house of John F. McClenney, recently occupied by R. B. P. Cobb, situated in the town of Franklin on the east side of Main Street, the said Stock of Goods herein conveyed, consisting of a general line of Groceries Liquor Stores and Bar fixtures to have and to hold the aforesaid Stock of Goods to him the said K. A. Griffin trustee his heirs and assigns forever ~~in trust~~ to secure to James I. Beale of the County of Southampton the payment of six several notes bearing date and payable as follows: One note for the sum of one hundred and Sixty $\frac{3}{4}$ dollars bearing date on the 18th day of February 1880, and payable thirty days after date, one other note for the sum of one hundred and Sixty $\frac{3}{4}$ dollars bearing date on the 18th day of February 1880, and payable three months after date, one other note for the sum of one hundred and Sixty $\frac{3}{4}$ dollars bearing date on the 18th day of February 1880 and payable four months after date, one other note for the sum of one hundred and Sixty $\frac{3}{4}$ dollars bearing date on the 18th day of February 1880, and payable five months after date, and one other note for the sum of one hundred and Sixty $\frac{3}{4}$ dollars bearing date on the 18th day of February 1880, and payable six months after date, all of which said notes are signed by the said party of the first part herein. And the said party of the first part covenants that should he make default and fail to pay either of the aforesaid notes as it becomes due, then the said K. A. Griffin trustee shall at the instance of the said James I. Beale proceed to sell after ten days notice of time and place of sale the property herein, conveyed to secure the payment of the aforesaid notes.
