This Agreement made this 22 day of March in the year 1880 between C. B. Williams of the first part, and Benj. T. Artis of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia: Witnesseth as follows: Whereas, the said Benj. T. Artis is engaged in, or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said C. B. Williams shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said C. B. Williams has agreed to do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth; That the said C. B. Williams does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Benj. T. Artis, during the present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies, (not exceeding the sum of Fifty dollars in amount) as may be needful to enable the
