This Agreement entered into this 22nd Day of March
 1880 between Jas. J. Darden, of the first part and John
 W. Edwards of the other part witnesseth as follows:
 That whereas the said John W. Edwards is about to
 engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous
 to obtain supplies during the year 1880 from
 the said Jas. J. Darden for the amount of Seven
 five Dollars and fortating the acknowledgement
 and for recording this Agreement, and the said
 Jas. J. Darden having on his part agreed to furnish
 Said supplies, Now the said Jas. J. Edwards
 on his part and in consideration of the above
 provisions doth hereby grant a Liens to the said
 Jas. J. Darden, on his crops of all kinds made
 on Mrs. Foggs Land the year 1880 and I hereby
 waive the benefit of my homestead exemption as
 to this debt or contract for the amount advanced
 to him this year which has been or was intended
 to have been expended, and the said Edwards binds
 himself agreeable to law to deliver said crops above
 mentioned to Jas. J. Darden at Newtons Depot Va., by
 or before the 1st Day of December 1880. This Liens is
 granted under an Act of the General Assembly of
 Virginia, approved April 2nd 1870 entitled "an act to
 secure the advances for agricultural purposes." Witness
