This Agreement made and entered into this 29th day of March 1880 between Darden & Myrick of the first part and Manirva Woodson of the other part, witnesseth as follows; that whereas the said Manirva Woodson is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1880, from the said Darden & Myrick for the amount of thirty Dollars, beyond which amount the said Woodson shall not go and the said Darden & Myrick having on their part agreed to furnish said supplies, Now the said Woodson on her part, and in consideration of the above provisions, doth hereby grant a lien to the said Darden & Myrick on all the crops which may be made during the year 1880 upon the lands of which the said Woodson cultivates for the above amount of advances which has been or was intended to have been expended. Now it is further agreed by the parties to this agreement, that the said Darden & Myrick shall be first paid and satisfied, after which the balance if any shall be first paid over to the said Woodson. This Lien is granted under an act of the general assembly of Virginia Approved April 2/73 entitled and act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes.
