

this agreement made this 30th day of March 1880, between Said M. C. This Agreement entered into this 27th day of April 1880, between Jas. J. Darden of the first part and Miles Sykes of the other part witnesseth as follows: That whereas the said Miles Sykes is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1880 from the said Jas. J. Darden for the amount of Forty Dollars and for taking the aforesaid amount and for recording this Agreement, and the said Jas. J. Darden, having on his part agreed to furnish said supplies, doth hereby grant unto the said Miles Sykes on his part and in consideration of the above provisions doth hereby grant a Lien to the said Jas. J. Darden on one or one Ball of Middling and fifty Pounds to be made this year and for the payment of which the said Sykes retained the benefit of his exemptions. For the amount advanced to him this year which has been or was intended to have been expended, and the said Sykes binds himself agreeable to leave to deliver
