This Agreement made this 8 day of April in the year 1880 between J. P. Coland of the first part and Henry Jones of the other part, both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia: Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Henry Jones is engaged in, or about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said J. P. Coland shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which the said J. P. Coland has agreed to do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth, That the said J. P. Coland does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Henry Jones during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Seventy five Dollars in amount) as may be needful to enable the said Henry Jones to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Henry Jones hereby gives and grants to the said J. P. Coland a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year, to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in presence of An Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2. 1873. Witness our Hands this 8th. day of April 1880.
