This Agreement made this 28th Feb'y 1880 between Alfred Cole and J. H. & J. B. Prinice. Witnesseth that in as much as said Alfred Cole is engaged in agriculture and desires advances and supplies to an amount not exceeding Sixty Dollars and also one ton Allison's Star Brand Manure and whereas the said J. H. & J. B. Prinice are willing and have agreed to furnish said Alfred Cole to an amount not exceeding Sixty Dollars and also $\frac{3}{4}$ ton A & A's Star Brand Manure. Now therefore the said Alfred Cole hereby gives and grants as lien upon his crops cotton, corn & fodder. The Manure to be paid for with bale cotton grade middling to weigh 425 lbs. per ton to be delivered at Bellfield by Nov. 1: 1880 and the said Alfred Cole also gives as lien upon one Mule, one cart and wheels.

This Agreement made this 10th April 1880 between Isaac Thomas and J. H. & J. B. Prinice. Witnesseth that in as much as said Isaac Thomas is engaged in Agriculture and desires advances and supplies to an amount not exceeding fifty dollars and one ton Allison's Star Brand Manure & whereas the said J. H. & J. B. Prinice have agreed to furnish said Isaac Thomas to an amount not exceeding fifty dollars and also one ton A & A's Star Brand Manure to be paid for with bale cotton to weigh 425 lbs. grade middling to be delivered at Bellfield by Nov. 1: 1880. Now therefore the said Isaac Thomas hereby gives & grants as lien upon three Bales cotton to be delivered at Bellfield by Nov. 1: 1880. Witness the following
