This Agreement made this 28th Feby. 1880 between Alfred Cole and J. H. & J. B. Prince Witneseth that in as much as said Alfred Cole is engaged in agriculture and desires advances and supplies to an amount not exceeding Sixty Dollars and also one Acre or Addison Star Brand Manure and whereas the said J. H. & J. B. Prince are willing and have agreed to furnish said Alfred Cole to an amount not exceeding Sixty Dollars and also  $\frac{1}{2}$  ton of A & A's Star Brand Manure. Now therefore the said Alfred Cole hereby gives and grants a lien upon his crops cotton, corn & fodder. The Manure to be paid for with bale cotton grade middling to weigh 425 lbs. per ton to be delivered at Bellfield by Mar. 1. 1880 and the said Alfred Cole also gives a lien upon one Mule, one cart and wheels.
