 and have agreed to furnish said Said Rec'd to an  
 amount not exceeding ~~one hundred~~ & fifty dollars and  
 also 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  tons of J. B. Manure. Now therefore the said Said  
 Rec'd hereby gives and grants a lien upon all his crops,  
 Cotton, Corn & fodder grown during the year 1880. The Manure  
 to be paid for with 7 $\frac{1}{2}$  bales cotton to weight 425 lbs per  
 bale grade middling & delivered at Buellfield by 1st day  
 Mar. 1880 and the said Said Rec'd also gives as liens to several

 and desires advanced and supplies to an amount  
 not exceeding Sixty Dollars and also one ton Allison's  
 Addison's Star Brand Manure, and whereas the said  
 J. H. & J. B. Prince are willing & have agreed to furnish  
 Said Anthony Browne to an amount not exceeding  
 Sixty Dollars and also one ton A. & A's Star Brand  
 Manure. Now therefore the said Anthony Browne  
 hereby gives a lien to said J. H. & J. B. Prince upon  
 all his crops, cotton, corn & fodder grown during the  
 year 1880 or so much thereof as it will take to satisfy  
 the said debt. The Manure to be paid for with bale cotton
