This Deed made and executed this 20th day of March Eighteen hundred and Eighty, betweenly Washington Holland and Mary A. his wife of the County of Southampton, and State of Virginia, of the one part and Augustus Compton Allen H. Cotton and Daniel Bradshaw deacons and trustees of the Sycamore Baptist Church, ^{in the County of Southampton, State} Tennessee. That the said ly Washington Holland, and Mary A. his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, to them in hand paid by the deacons and trustees aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given granted and released to the deacons and trustees aforesaid and to their successors in office, ad infinitum, Forty-three one hundred and fifty seven one hundredth of an acre, delineated by Allen H. Cotton & wife to said deacons and trustees beginning at a dogwood, from thence 3.6 Chaineth an ox, thence 77 chaineth a sycamore wood, thence 1.96 chaineth a pine, thence to the first Station, which land is constituta part of the church land aforesaid.
