This Deed made and recited this 20th day of March Eighteen Hundred and Eighty, between by Washington Holland and Mary A. his wife of the County of Southampton, and State of Virginia, of the one part, and Augustus Loomis, Allen H. Cotton and Daniel Bragshaw deacons and trustees of the ^{Church of the said County of Virginia} ~~Episcopal~~ Baptist Church, of the said by Washington Holland, and Mary A. his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar, to them in hand paid, by the deacons and trustees aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have given, granted and released to the deacons and trustees aforesaid and to their successors in office, ad infinitum, Forty three and one hundredth of an acre of land lying contiguous to one acre and fifty seven one hundredth of an acre, donated by Allen H. Cotton, wife, to said deacons and trustees beginning at a dogwood, from thence S. 6 chains to an oak thence 77 chains to a dogwood, thence 1.96 chains to a pine, thence to the first Station, which land is now used as a part of the Church land aforesaid.
