This Deed, made this fourteenth day of April one
thousand eight hundred and Eighty between John
P. Pittman and Annie E. his wife, of Southampton
County parties of the first part, and French Mason
of the County of Southampton, party of the second
part, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum
of one hundred dollars, the said John P. Pittman
and Anna E. his wife do grant unto the said French
Mason with general warranty all right title and in-
terest in thirty seven acres of land, bounded on North
& East by the lands of Atlantic Miss. & Chic. C. Co.
Company, on the South by the lands of W. B. My-
rickson, on the West by the lands of Kinsey Parkman. The
said John P. Pittman and Anna E. his wife covenan-
ts that they have the right to convey the said land
to the grantee; that they have done no act to encumber
the said land, that the grantee shall have quiet
possession of the said land, free from all encum-
brances, and that they, the said parties of the first
part, will execute such further assurances of the
