This Agreement made and entered into this 1st day of March 1880 between Wilmers Ethredge & Brooks of Portsmouth Va. of the first part and James Kees of Southampton County, Va. of the second, Witnesseth that whereas the said James Kees is engaged in the cultivation of the said, in the County of Southampton, and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1880 from the said Wilmers, Ethredge & Brooks to carry on his crops, and the said Wilmers, Ethredge & Brooks having agreed to furnish said supplies, and in consideration of the above advances and promises the said James Kees doth hereby grant a lien to the said Wilmers, Ethredge & Brooks, on all of his portion of the crops which he may make, except one half of bottom during the year 1880, upon the farm known as the "Lonek plantation" for the amount of above advances. And it is further agreed by the said parties to this agreement that the crops above referred to is to be delivered at Newmarket Depot by the said James Kees to be shipped to the said Wilmers, Ethredge & Brooks as fast as it can be prepared for market.

Barden is engaged in the cultivation of the said, and is desirous to obtain advances in money to purchase supplies to carry on his farming operations during the year 1880 to the amount of three hundred dollars from the said Goodwin D. Cutler, and the said Goodwin D. Cutler having agreed to advance the said three hundred dollars in money, and the said Leitch B. Barden in consideration of the above promises doth hereby grant a lien on all the crops made during 1880 to the said Goodwin D. Cutler excepting his plant crops, upon the lands on which the said Advances of three hundred dollars was
