Know all men by these Presents, That I Edgar B. Beaton of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do bargain and sell, and by these presents deliver unto James M. Corbitt of the same County & State three hundred & fifty cords of pine wood to be delivered on the S.W. 1/4 of the north side of same, between the fifty & fifty-one mile post, said wood to be put on the said land at the above designated place by the first day of June next, to have and to hold the said wood and to erect the mill from the Treasury of the said Rail Road for his own use and behoof forever. And I do covenant with the said James M. Corbitt that I will lawfully possess of the same, that I will covenant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims of any or all persons whomsoever. Witness my hand and seal this 20th day of April 1880.
