Chas. & Co. agree on this part to furnish supplies money to the said W. H. Drury to the amount of Fifteen Hundred Dollars to enable him to carry on his business operations in the County of Southampton, State of Virginia the present year & in consideration of said advance money to be made by Nicomys E. Chas. & Co. to the said Wm. H. Drury he binds himself to give them all his crops cotton & this shall constitute a lien on all of his crops & cotton crop until they are paid & do hereby waive the benefit of any Homestead exemption as to this debt.
