Exhibit 3 This Agreement, made this first day of May 1880 between  
Walter S. Barlow of Southampton County, of the one  
part and Stat. D. Gell of the same County of the other  
part witnesseth: That whereas the said Stat. D. Gell  
is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is  
desirous to obtain advances in supplies from the said  
Walter S. Barlow to enable him to carry on his farm-  
ing operations, during the year 1880 to the amount  
of two hundred and ninety dollars beyond which  
limit the said Stat. D. Gell shall not go; and the said  
Walter S. Barlow having agreed on his part to furnish said  
amount of supplies, have the said Stat. D. Gell on his  
part in consideration of the above premises, do hereby  
grant a Lien to the said Walter S. Barlow on all the  
produce made during the year 1880, upon the lands on  
which the said amount of advances, has been or may be  
intended to have been expended.

This Lien is granted under an Act of the General  
Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd, 1873  
entitled "An Act to Secure Advances for Agricul-  
tural Purposes." Witness the foregoing signatures.
