

R. B. Pyle does hereby promise and agree to and warrant
 furnish to the said Thos. McClelleny & Thos. McClelleny during
 the present year, such manure, provisions, fertilizers and other
 supplies, & not exceeding the sum of Fifty Dollars in amount
 as may be needful to enable the said Thos. McClelleny and
 Thos. McClelleny to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be
 sown the present year, and the said Thos. McClelleny &
 Thos. McClelleny hereby give and grant to the said R. B. Pyle
 a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present
 year, to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cattle and all other
 crops in order to secure the payment of said such supplies
 and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the
 sum above stated. This Agreement is made in presence
 of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, passed

 his part agreed to furnish said supplies, and the said
 Allen Banks on his part and in consideration of the above
 provisions doth hereby grant a Lien to the said Jas. J. Darden
 on his crop of cotton to be made on Jack Paddock Island
