the above provisions doth hereby grant and give to the said
Jas. J. Darden on his crop of all kinds which he will
break on the Land where he may live, and the said
Jas. J. Darden waives his benefit of the Homestead
Exemption as to this debt or contract. But the amount
advanced to him this year which has been or is intended
to have been expended, and the said Jas. J. Darden agrees
able to him to deliver said crop above mentioned to
Jas. J. Darden, at Parsons Depot or by or before the 1st day of
