Prince Trustee the following property, to wit a certain tract of land situated in Southampton County said to contain Two hundred (200) acres more or less, it being known as a part of Everett Quarter bounded at follows, North w^s the lands of S. W. Doughtery & others east by the Notterway River, South by the land of James M. Coulter West by the lands of D^r W. H. Daugherty & others with all the appurtenances belonging thereto. In Trust to secure a debt due by bond of even date with this Deed, for one hundred & Sixty five Dollars \$165⁰⁰ due cordly & Whitfield by said Lewis Riddick, and it is agreed by the parties to this Deed, that no sale shall take place by virtue of this Deed for the period of twelve months from this date, and it is further agreed that in case of a sale it shall be upon verbal^{w^s} to the Trustee after 60 days notice of time & place upon such terms as the said Whitfield may propose, the parties to these presents have presents set their hands & seals this the herein before mentioned date & year.
