advances and promises, the said Lewis Brown
doth hereby grant a Lien to the said Pope & Gillette
on all the crops which may be made during the
year 1880 upon the land which the said Lewis Brown
doth cultivate or has cultivated by tenants for the
amount of above advances. And it is further agreed
by the said parties to this agreement that the crop
above referred to is to be delivered to the said Pope &
Gillette on or before the first day of December 1880
