Doraen of the other part all of Southampton County Virginia Witnesseth: That whereas the said Samuel Drake is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and it is necessary to obtain supplies from the said R. E. Doraen to the amount of Eighty six Dollars and twenty five cents viz and which limit the said Samuel Drake shall not go, and the said R. E. Doraen having agreed to furnish said advances in supplies, now the said Samuel Drake on his part in consideration of the above premises do hereby grant a Lien on all the crops raised during the year 1880 upon the lands on which the said amount has been or was intended to have been expended. This Lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2nd 1873 Entitled "An Act to secure Advances for Agricultural Purposes" Witness the foregoing signatures.
