This Agreement, made this 15th day of May in the
 year 1880, between J. P. Leland of the first part,
 & Richard Jones of the other part both of the County
 of Southampton State of Virginia, Witnesseth as
 follows: Whereas the said Richard Jones is engaged
 in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the
 soil, and is desirous that the said J. P. Leland shall
 during the present year make certain advances
 to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said J. P. L.
 has agreed to do, to have this Agreement Witnesseth
 That the said J. P. Leland does hereby promise
 and agree to advance and furnish to the said
 Richard Jones, during the present year, such money,
 provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not
 exceeding the sum of Thirty five Dollars) as
 may be needed to enable the said Richard
 Jones to cultivate and gather his crop before
 to be made the present year, And the said
 Richard Jones hereby gives and grants to the said
 J. P. Leland a bill upon all such crops
 he may make the present year, to wit: Corn,
 Cotton, Peas, Peanuts, Potatoes and all other
 crops, in order to receive the payment for all
 such supplies and advances as may be
 actually made not exceeding the sum above
 stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance
 of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia
 approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this
 15th day of May 1880.
