 This Agreement made this 15th day of May in the
 year 1880 between J. P. Ploland of the first part, and
 Richard Jones of the other part both of the County
 of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth
 the said J. P. Ploland, Whereas the said Richard Jones is engaged
 in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the
 soil, and is desirous that the said J. P. Ploland shall
 during the present year make certain advance
 to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said J. P. Ploland
 has agreed to do, Now this Agreement Witnesseth
 that the said J. P. Ploland does hereby promise
 and agree to advance and furnish to the said
 Richard Jones during the present year such money
 provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not
 exceeding the sum of thirty five Dollars in amount)
 as may be needful to enable the said Richard
 Jones to cultivate and gather his crops proposed
 to be made the present year. And the said
 Richard Jones hereby gives and grants to the said
 J. P. Ploland a lien upon all such crops
 the may make the present year, to wit: Corn,
 Potatoes, Peas, Peanuts, cotton, and all other
 crops, in order to secure the payment for all
 such supplies and advances as may be
 actually made not exceeding the sum above
 stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance
 of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia
 approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this
 15th day of May 1880.
