

Exa. This Agreement made this 22nd day of May in the year 1850 between  
 J. P. Blount of the first part, and Charles H. Blunt of the  
 other part both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia  
 Witness as follows: Whereas the said Charles H. Blunt  
 is engaged in, or is about to engage in the cultivation of  
 the soil, and it appears that the said J. P. Blount shall  
 during the present year make certain advances to the said  
 cultivator of the soil, which the said J. P. Blount has agreed to  
 do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth, That the said J. P. Blount  
 doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish  
 to the said Charles H. Blunt during the present  
 year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and  
 other supplies (not exceeding the sum of twenty five  
 dollar in amount) as may be needful to enable  
 the said Charles H. Blunt to cultivate and gather  
 his crops proposed to be made the present year, And  
 the said Charles H. Blunt hereby gives and grants  
 to the said J. P. Blount a lien upon all such crops  
 as he may make the present year, to wit, corn, Grass,  
 Peas, Peanuts, cotton and all other crops, in order to  
 secure the payment for all such supplies and  
 advances as may be actually made, not exceeding  
 the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in  
 pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of  
 Virginia, approved April 28th 1842. Witness our hands  
 this 22 day of May 1850

Exa. This Agreement made this 22nd day of May A. D. 1850  
 between John Peltier Jr of Southampton County  
 Virginia of the one part and Richard H. Pauls of the  
 same County, of the other part Witnesseth: That whereas  
 the said Richard H. Pauls shall have paid within  
 the period of five years from the date of this agreement  
 and during said period, to said Peltier the sum of  
 one hundred (100) dollars in a currency equal to  
 gold in value at the time of the payment of  
 the same and shall have regularly also paid  
 to said Peltier interest on said sum of one hundred  
 dollars semi-annually on the first day of February A. D. 1850 till said money
