This deed made the 13th day of May 1880 between L. Girard grantor, of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia of the first part and John W. Lawrence chosen as trustee of the same County and State of the second part with covenants; That in order to secure the payment of a note bearing even date with this one for 50 Dollars and due by the said Girard the 1st day of November 1880 unto W. H. Jenkins & Co, said note being made by the said Girard for advances made and to be made by the said W. H. Jenkins & Co from their Store in the Town of Franklin unto the said Girard in order to assist him in cultivating his crop during the year, he the said L. Girard doth grant and convey unto the said John W. Lawrence the following crops which the said Girard has planted and is cultivating during this year on the farm belonging to A. D. Boyd and John Jenkins in the said County of Southampton to wit: nine acres of peanuts And the said Girard states that he has made no other conveyance nor created any other lien on said crop for any purpose whatever this conveyance is made in trust to secure the above mentioned note of tenancy five Dollars due as aforesaid, And the said Girard binds himself to deliver said peanuts to the said Jenkins & Co on or to John W. Lawrence in Franklin whenever they are demanded. And should he fail to deliver them as per above agreement then it shall be the duty of said Trustee to take possession of said peanuts, sell them and apply the proceeds to
