This Deed made this 7th day of May 1880 between
J. H. Drake of the County of Southampton State of
Virginia grantor of the first part and John W. Law-
rence of the same County, and State as above trustee
of the second part. Witnesseth: that in order
to secure the payment of a certain debt
payable to W. H. Jenkins & Co by the said John
H. Drake both grant and convey unto the said
John W. Lawrence the following crops to wit
26 acres of peanuts 3 acres of Cotton and 3000
of corn all of which he the said Drake has
planted and is cultivating on his farm where
he resides in the said County of Southampton
we trust to secure the above mentioned debt
which is evidenced by one note for \$1500 dated
May 7th 1880 and due unto the said W. H. Jenkins
& Co for goods to be furnished by them from this
Store in the Town of Pamunkey, while the said Drake
to assist him in cultivating his said crops of
