

Grand This Agreement made and entered into this the first day of May 1880 between J. E. Bailey of the first part and Richard Stith of the second part Witnesses as follows: That whereas the said Richard Stith is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies of fertilizers &c. during the year 1880 from the said J. E. Bailey for the amount of one hundred & twenty five dollars and the said Bailey having agreed to furnish the said supplies now the said Stith on his part and in consideration of the above advances & promises does hereby grant unto the said Bailey a Lease on all the crops that may be made during the year 1880 upon the lands that the said Stith cultivates for the amt. of the above advances & cost of this Agreement. It is further now agreed by the Parties to this Agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to the said Bailey on or before the first day of Dec. 1880 and no part of said crops shall be sold until it is by and through the said Bailey until this Agreement is satisfied.
