Bailey for the sum of one Thousand Dollars and the said Bailey having agreed to furnish the said supplies now the said George Stith on his part and in consideration of the above advanced promises does hereby grant unto the said J. E. Bailey a Lien on all the crops that may be made during the year 1870 upon the land that the said Stith cultivates for the aunts of the above advanced & cost of this Agreement. It is furthermore agreed by the Parties to this Agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to the said Bailey Augt 1870 before the first day of Dec 1870 and no part of said crops shall be sold until it is by and through the said Bailey until this Agreement is satisfied.
