For this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said
 Barham & Turner do hereby promise and agree
 to advance and furnish to the said William
 Whitfield during the present year, such manure,
 provisions, fertilizers and other supplies, not
 exceeding the sum of Twenty Five Dollars in
 amount, as may be needful to enable the
 said William Whitfield to cultivate and
 gather his crops proposed to be made the
 present year. And the said William Whitfield
 hereby gives and grants to the said Barham &
 Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may
 make the present year, to wit Corn, Potatoes, Peas,
 Peanuts, Cottoy and all other crops in order
 to secure the Payment for all such supplies
 and advances as may be actually made, not
 exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement
 is made in pursuance of an Act of the
 General Assembly of Virginia, approved
 April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 2nd
 day of May, 1880.

This Agreement made this 3rd day of May in the
 year 1880 between Chas. Ricks of the first part
 Barham & Turner of the other part, both of the
 County of Southampton State of Virginia
 Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Chas.
 Ricks is engaged in, or is about to engage in the
 cultivation of the soil, and it desired that
 the said Barham & Turner shall during the
 present year make certain advances to the
 said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham &
 Turner has agreed to do. Now This Agreement
 Witnesseth that the said Barham & Turner do hereby
 promise and agree to advance and furnish to the
 said Chas. Ricks, during the present year
