For this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said
Barham & Turner does hereby promise and agree
to advance and furnish to the said William
Whitfield during the present year such moneys,
provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not
exceeding the sum of Twenty Five Dollars in
amount as may be needful to enable the
said William Whitfield to cultivate and
gather his crops proposed to be made the
present year. And the said William Whitfield
hereby gives and grants to the said Barham &
Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may
make the present year to wit Corn, Potatoes,
Peanuts, cotton and all other crops in order
to secure the Payment for all such supplies
and advances as may be actually made, not
exceeding the sum aforesaid. This Agreement
is made in pursuance of an Act of the
General Assembly of Virginia, approved
April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 2nd
day of May 1880.
