This Agreement made this 20 day of May in the year 1880 between Reuben Gray of the first part and Barham & Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia: Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Reuben Gray is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Turner has agreed to do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said Barham & Turner does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Reuben Gray during the present year, such money, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Twenty Dollars ~~dollars~~ in amount) as may be needed to enable the said Reuben Gray to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Reuben Gray hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit: Corn, Paddy, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands, this 20 day of May 1880.
