

make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Turner have agreed to do. This Agreement Witnesseth: That the said Barham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Bird Gray during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Fifty Dollars or more in amount as may be needed to enable the said Bird Gray to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Bird Gray hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Turner a discharge of all such crops as he may make the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment of all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.

This Agreement is made in presence of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2d 1873. Witness our hands this 10th day of May 1880.
