This Agreement made this 1st day of May in the
 year 1880, between John H. Higgins of the first
 part and Barham & Turner of the other part
 both of the County of Southampton, State of
 Virginia: Witnesseth as follows: It is agreed
 that the said John H. Higgins is engaged in, or is about
 to engage in, the cultivation of the soil, and is
 desirous that the said Barham & Turner shall
 during the present year make certain advances
 to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said
 John H. Higgins has agreed to do. Now this Agreement
 Witnesseth that the said Barham & Turner do
 hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish
 to the said John H. Higgins during the present year
 such monies, provisions, fertilizers, and other
 supplies (not exceeding the sum of Thirty Dollars
 in amount) as may be needed to enable the said
 John H. Higgins to cultivate and gather his
 crops proposed to be made the present year
 to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cabbages and
 all other crops in order to secure the payment
 for all such supplies and advances so may
 be actually made, not exceeding the sum
 above stated. This Agreement is made in
 pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly
 of Virginia, approved April 2nd 1873. Witness our hands
 this 1st day of May 1880.
