This Agreement made this 1st day of May in the year 1880 between P. J. Johnson of the first part and Barham & Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth It follows: Whereas, the said P. J. Johnson is engaged in, or is about to engage in, the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Turner has agreed to do; and this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said Barham & Turner does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said P. J. Johnson during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Twenty five Dollars in amount) as may be needful to enable the said P. J. Johnson to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year, to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated.
