

THIS AGREEMENT

Examined
and delivered to
Barham & Turner

made this 30th day of April in the year 1882 between Joshua Irving of the first part and Barham & Turner of the other part both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia: Witnesseth as follows:
Whereas the said Joshua Irving is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and it is his intent that the said Barham & Turner should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Joshua Irving has agreed to do, in this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said Barham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Joshua Irving during the present year such monies for provisions, fertilizers, and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Twenty Dollars in amount as may be needed to enable the said Joshua Irving to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Joshua Irving hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Turner a Lien upon all such crops as they may make the present year, to wit: Corn, Paddy, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 28, 1873. Witness our hands this 30th day of April 1882.
