This Agreement made this 23rd day of April in the year 1850 between Wickerson Ford of the first part, and Barham & Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: That the said Wickerson Ford is engaged in, or and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Turner has agreed to do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said Barham & Turner does hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Wickerson Ford during the present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Twenty Five Dollars, dollars in amount) as may be necessary to enable the said Wickerson Ford to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Wickerson Ford hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year, to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton, and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in presence of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1853. Witness our hands this 23rd day of April 1850.
