This Agreement made this 25th day of April in the year 1880
between John Spratley, of the first part and Barham
Turner of the other part, both of the County of
Southampton, State of Virginia: Witnesseth as
follows: Whereas the said John Spratley is engaged
in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil
and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner
shall during the present year make certain
advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which
the said John Spratley was agreed to do.
Now this Agreement Witnesseth: That the said
Barham & Turner do hereby promise, and
agree to advance and furnish to the said John
Spratley during the present year such supplies
provisions, fertilizers and other supplies
not exceeding the sum of Fifteen Dollars in amount,
as may be needed to enable the said John
Spratley to cultivate and gather his crop proposed
to be made the Present year. And the said
John Spratley hereby gives and grants to the
said Barham & Turner, a lien upon all such
crops as he may make the present year to wit
corn, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other
crops in or about due the payment for all
such supplies and advances as may be
actually made not exceeding the sum above
stated. This Agreement is made in presence of
