This Agreement made and entered into this 7th day of June 1880 between Joseph B. Pope of the 1st part and Richard L. Vincent of the 2nd part both of the County of Southampton and State of Va. Witnesseth as follows: That whereas the said Vincent is engaged in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1880 from the said Pope to the amount of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450.00) in gold which amount he shall not pay, and the said Pope having engaged to furnish the said supplies Now the said Vincent on his part and in consideration of the above advances and premises doth hereby grant a Lien to the said Pope on all the crops which may be made during the year 1880 upon the lands which the said Vincent cultivate for the amount of the above advances and cost of this Agreement. It is furthermore agreed by the parties to this Agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to the said Pope on or before the 1st day of December next, and that no part of said crops are to be sold until it is by and through the said Pope until this Agreement is satisfied. This Lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1843, entitled an act to secure advances for Agricultural Purposes. Witness the foregoing signatures this day and date above said.
