This Agreement made this 29th day of May A.D. Eighteen hundred and eighty, between Babie and Cooke of No. 602 Vicksburg of the first part, and J. G. Prellow acting agent for his wife Mrs. H. Virginia Prellow and for Robert H. Whitlocke her trustee of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the second part Witnesseth: that the said Parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the premises hereinafter stated, do hereby promise and agree to furnish and advance during the present year, to the said party of the second part, who is engaged in the business of cultivating the soil, the sum of Three Hundred & Dollars, beyond which amount he shall not go. And the said Party of the second part, for the purpose of securing the payment of the said sum, or so much thereof as may be advanced to him, do hereby grant with convey unto the said Party at the first Part all his crops of Peanuts, and cotton, which the said party of the second part may raise and produce. During the present year, on the place where he now resides known as the "Westphalia" farm which said farm is situated in said County within three or four miles of Jerusalem, and which said "Westphalia" farm sometimes called the "Horse Place" is the property of Mrs. H.
