 This Deed made this the 17th day of May A.D. 1880 between
 W. M. Beaton (Trustee) party of the first part, Jas. H. Harrison
 party of the second part and David Wiesenfeld
 of the third part. Whereas by a deed of Trust dated
 on the 22nd day of April 1876 and of record in the
 Clerk's Office of Southampton County, Va., the said
 John H. Harrison did secure the payment of an open
 account of Two Thousand Dollars due to the said David
 Wiesenfeld, and did convey in trust to the said W.
 M. Beaton certain property set forth and described in
 said deed as follows: That portion of land lying and
 being at Branchville Depot Va. That is to say one tract
 or parcel of land containing five acres be the
 same more or less, and on which lot or parcel of land
 is a Store house now occupied by the said Jas. H. Harrison
 and the said parcel or lot of land is bounded by
 the lands of the Seaboard and Roanoke R. Road,
 Miles to Williams R. R. Cuts and the estate of Lewis
 Hall and died, and whereas the said open account
 has been fully paid and the said Jas. H. Harrison
 desires the said property released to him, I do, therefore
 this deed witnesseth, that the said W. M. Beaton Trustee
 as aforesaid in consideration of the premises and
 by and the consent of the said David Wiesenfeld, testifies
 that he becoming a party to this deed and signing
 and sealing the same, doth grant and release unto
 the said John H. Harrison all that parcel or lot of
