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This Deed, made this the 1st day of June A.D. 1880, between W^m N. Sebrell Trustee and Jas. E. Sebrell of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the first part, and Emmett P. Reese of the same County and State of the second part. Whereas by a deed dated January 17th 1877 and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton County, the said Emmett P. Reese in order to secure to the said Jas. E. Sebrell, the payment of a certain bond for the amount of one thousand Dollars, did convey in trust to the said W^m N. Sebrell, Trustee and James E. Sebrell do grant & release and recover with special warranty unto the said Emmett P.
