And Whereas the said Plaintiff has paid to the said Niemeyer, Etheredge & Brooks one hundred and Ninety dollars and Sixty cents in cash, and a draft or note on J. H. Bryant of the city of Richmond for Five hundred and fifteen Dollars, which will be due and payable Seven months from the 3rd day of Feby 1880, and which will be placed as a credit on said note of one thousand dollars which paid, and the said Lawson Beale desiring that a portion of said land shall be released. Now therefore this Deed witnesseth that for and in consideration of the above premises the said Niemeyer, Etheredge and ~~Brooks~~ and George L. Neville Trustee do remise, release and forever quit claim to the following land described and bounded as follows to wit a tract or parcel of land lying and being in Southampton Co Va. containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less, adjoining the lands of B. C. Waller, the said Beale, George E. Beaton & wife and the land of the heirs of John Whitehead deceased, commencing in the Whitehead Road and running North to a rotten Sophia tree, in the boundary line between B. C. Waller & said Beale, thence along said <sup>Waller's</sup> line to a corner in George E. Beaton's line, thence down the line between said Beaton & Beale to a pine tree which is the corner of said George E. Beaton & wife, said Beale & the heirs of John Whitehead and thence running back to said Whitehead Road. It being the land which the said Lawson Beale has sold to M. D. Gill and co. the said Niemeyer, Etheredge & Brooks & George L. Neville do also release the right of way left wide for a tramway through the lands of the said Beale to the Rail road, which is more fully described in Deed of Bargain and Sale to M. D.
