This Deed, made and entered into this the 31st day of January 1880, between Lawson Beale and Martha E. Beale his wife, Grantors of the first part and M. D. Dill & Co. M. S. Dill of the city of Portsmouth Virginia, and John B. Bryant of the city of Richmond Virginia, trading under the firm name of M. D. Dill & Co. Grantors of the second part. Witnesseth as follows: that for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred and fifty Dollars in hand paid to the said Lawson Beale and Martha E. his wife, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, do bargain, grant and sell and by these presents convey unto the said M. D. Dill and Co. grantors as aforesaid with general warranty a certain tract or parcel of land situated and being in Southampton County, adjoining the lands of B. B. Warner the said Lawson Beale, George E. Beaton and wife and the lands of the heirs of John Whitehead dec. commencing in the White Road and running North to a rotten top pine tree, in the boundary line between B. B. Warner and said Beale, thence along said Warner's line to a corner in George E. Beaton's line, thence down the line between said Beaton & Beale to a pine tree, which is the corner of said George E.
