This Deed, made this 24th day of June in the year 1880, between
John H. Cooke, Trustee of the City of Richmond, Va. of the
first part, Archer Anderson of the said city of the second
part, and the City Fire Insurance Company of Richmond Va.
of the third part. Whereas the said Archer Anderson in
order to secure the payment of the sum of the negoti-
able notes each dated the 27th of November 1878 each
drawn by Archer Anderson payable to the order of G. D.
Glasgow and by him endorsed in blood and
payable at First National Bank of Richmond, one
at six months for Ninety Dollars, one at twelve months
for a like amount, and one at twelve months for
three thousand dollars, and likewise to secure any
notes given in renewal of above mentioned notes in
whole or in part did by his deed bearing date on
the 27th day of November 1878 recorded in the office
of the Clerk of Southampton County Court convey
to the said John H. Cooke trustee his heirs and assigns
a certain real estate described in said deed,
as follows: that certain tract of land in this County
of Southampton known as "Fortsville" containing
nine hundred acres being the same tract of land con-
veyed to James H. Cook by Lewis C. Mason by and dated
1st of April 1859 and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office
of the County Court of Southampton and conveyed to said
Archer Anderson by Joseph B. Finney and Joseph C. Reid
Commissioners under a deed of Circuit Court of Greensville
in Suit of Cook's Edo. of 1860 &c. by and dated the 9th
day of November 1878. And whereas said three negotiable
notes for value received, were assigned and delivered to the
said City Fire Insurance Co. of Richmond Va. and have
been fully paid and discharged, without renewal thereof,
either in whole or in part, as has been evidenced to said
Trustee, by the production to him of all of said notes
duly cancelled, as well as by said City Fire Insurance
Co. of Richmond Va. uniting in this deed in confirmation
thereof, and signing the same be the said Archer Anderson
has requested that the estate conveyed by said deed of trust
to the said John H. Cooke trustee in the said property herein
before mentioned and described, be now released to him,
the said Archer Anderson. This Deed therefore it is with
that for and in consideration of the premises, as well as the
sum of five dollars the said John H. Cooke trustee, with the
consent of the said City Fire Insurance Co. of Richmond Va. signified
by its signing and sealing this deed doth release to the said Archer Anderson
all his claims upon the said property. Witness the following sig-
