This Agreement made and entered into this 15th day of April A.D. 1880 between Benj. E. Hornell of the one part and George Story of the other part all of the Co. of Southampton and State of Virginia, witnesseth: That whereas the said George Story is engaged in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1880 from the said Benj. E. Hornell for the amount of one hundred Dollars and thirty six cents, and the said Benj. E. Hornell having agreed to furnish said supplies, and in consideration of the above advances, and promises, the said George Story does hereby grant a lien to the said Benj. E. Hornell on all the crops which may be made during the year 1880 upon the lands which the said George Story does cultivate or has cultivated by tenants for the amt. of above advances. And it is further agreed by the said parties to this Agreement, that the crops above referred to, is to be delivered to the said Benj. E. Hornell on or before the 25th day of Decr next.
